**ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF ACTION
AGAINST SOME DEFENDANTS**

Plaintiffs have filed a notice of voluntary dismissal without prejudice as to their action against Attorney General Ashley Moody and Secretary of State Cord Byrd. ECF No. 34. The notice is effective without an order. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i); *Plains Growers, Inc. v. Ickes-Braun Glasshouses, Inc.*, 474 F.2d 250, 253 (5th Cir. 1973) (“[A] plaintiff is entitled to a dismissal against one defendant under Rule 41(a), even though the action against another defendant would remain pending.”); *see also Rosell v. VMSB, LLC*, 67 F.4th 1141, 1144 n.2 (11th Cir. 2023).

This order confirms that the case has been dismissed against Attorney General Ashley Moody and Secretary of State Cord Byrd. Future filings should omit them from the case style.

The now-dismissed Defendants' motions to dismiss (ECF Nos. 25 and 26) are
DENIED as moot.
